I am requesting funding for the City of Alpharetta, Bus Shelter Construction project in fiscal year 2022.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Alpharetta, located at 2 Park Plaza, Alpharetta, GA 30009.

This funding request is for the installation of two (2) new bus shelters in Downtown Alpharetta at existing bus stops. One on Haynes Bridge Road by the library; and a second on Main Street near Marietta Street. Designs will complement those installed by the North Fulton CID. This project enhances transit operations around the Downtown Alpharetta activity center. Transit investment within the Downtown activity center complements improvements throughout the area which have created an active walkable environment. Additional Bus shelters make MARTA bus service a more attractive transportation option for both those relying on transit as the only option as well as those making transit their transportation option of choice.
